

CoreKids is looking for a Sessional Play Therapist

CoreKids, a Westminster Drug Project service, is looking for an experienced Play Therapist, working on a sessional basis (7 hours per week), to join their team of specialists who work with parents, children and families affected by addiction. You will deliver play therapy sessions to children affected by parental substance use in a range of locations across London. The CoreKids team aims to help children to be safe and healthy, adults to be effective parents, and families to communicate.

This is a new 3-year post, funded by Children in Need, and will be based within the CoreKids team in Marylebone although most of the work will be carried out from community settings. The project is a new and innovative way of engaging with vulnerable children, by taking the service out to the community and working from within a range of child-friendly community venues such as schools, children's centres and family services.
